RAIDERS OF THE LOST ARCHIVE

Put down Taschen's stunning new tribute to Stanley Kubrick? I'm afraid we can't do that, Dave.



Granted full access by the estate of director Stanley Kubrick, editor Alison Castle has put together *The Stanley Kubrick Archives*, a mammoth insight into movies such as *Lolita*, *Dr. Strangelove* and *The Shining*. Taken from Kubrick's personal collections, the book contains 800 film stills scanned from the original reels, on-set photography (like this shot from the set of *2001: A Space Odyssey*), interviews, essays, pages from screenplay drafts, information on unfinished projects and much more. The coolest part? Every copy in the first-print run includes a 12-frame strip from a 70mm print of *2001* owned by Stan himself—making this package the collector's item of all collector's items.
