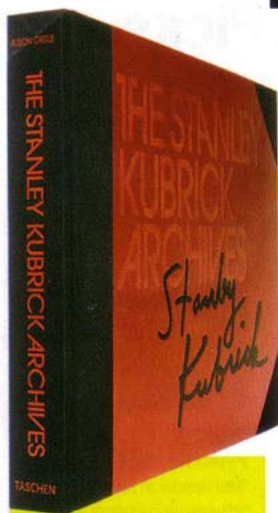


Tomes for the Holidays

Edited by Alison Castle, the 15-pound, 544-page tome features 800 frames from 12 of Kubrick's films, as well as hundreds of notes and set photos culled from the auteur's personal collection. A bonus CD contains a 1966 interview with Kubrick, which proves that he was not, in fact, a monklike mute.
