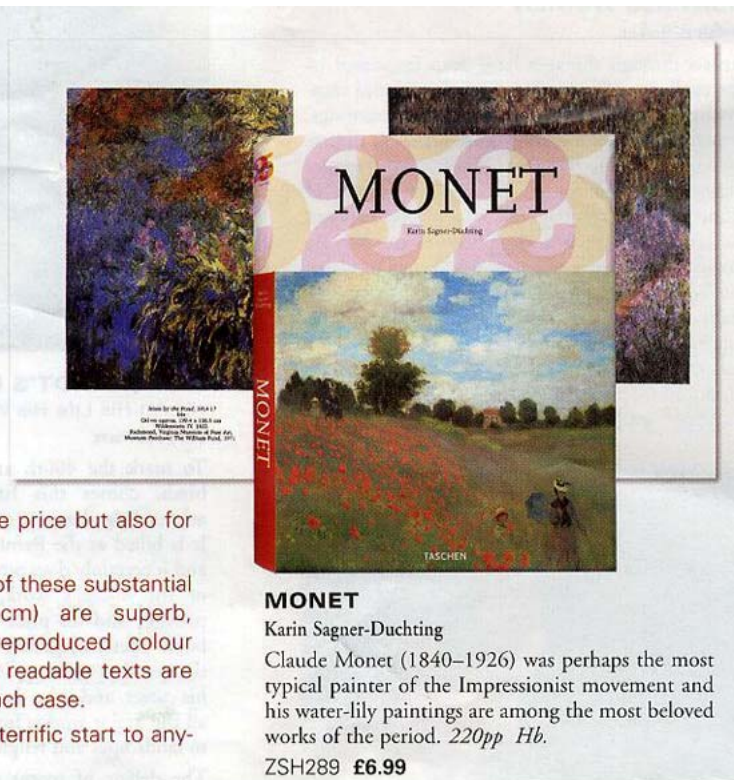


TOP ARTISTS FROM TASCHEN

These monographs of key figures in the history of late nineteenth- and twentieth-century art are being published in new editions by Taschen, to celebrate the publisher's 25th anniversary. They are remarkable not only for their reasonable price but also for their quality.

The production values of these substantial hardbacks (24 x 30cm) are superb, with plenty of well-reproduced colour illustrations. The highly readable texts are written by experts in each case.
