



Brought to book Travelogue pioneer Burton Holmes, whose work was mentioned here recently, has been dusted off and repackaged by trendy German publisher Taschen. *Burton Holmes Travelogues, The Greatest Traveler of His Time, 1892-1952* aims to “transport you to a time that has all but evaporated, and inspire you to strike out on a journey of your own”. Holmes’ essays and travelogue transcripts are put into context by editor Genoa Caldwell and illustrated with many of the photographs he took in his 60 years of travelling. Asian countries covered in the book include China, Japan, Korea and the Philippines. At the Taschen website (www.taschen.com) you can find excerpts from the book and a video clip showing some of Holmes’ early movie footage, much of it shot in China.
