**Courtney Love and a Kurt Cobain lookalike: dirty laundry, public etc.**

That's nice, isn't it? Certified charmer Courtney Love has posed with a lookalike of her late husband for the cover of *Heaven To Hell*, a supremely kitsch gallery of portraits by the colourful photographer and video director David LaChapelle. The "hyper-real" scene of domestic grief is awash with gruesome detail - medicine bottles, booze, freshly-minted track marks, grimy and rather knackered knickers, and even a *doppelgänger* of their luckless daughter Frances Bean, who was 20 months old at the time of her father's self-administered exit. This is the third part of a trilogy of books begun in 1996 with *LaChapelle Land* and followed in 1999

with *Hotel LaChapelle*, and you need to know that they all "call to question our relationship with gender, glamour and status". Which is achieved in this third volume via such images as Kanye West wearing a crown of thorns, Pamela Anderson topless in a tanning booth, a stark naked Paris Hilton wrapped in figure-hugging microphone leads, and - possibly on the "heaven" tip - Angelina Jolie's ecstatic face suggesting she's indulging in a spot of self-love in a field of poppies.
