Frequent flyer Sophy Roberts **fast-tracks international intelligence on where to be and what to see.**

Look out for the super-book of the season: a 616-page Art Edition of photographer Peter Beard's work measuring 34.5cm x 50cm and featuring diaries, collages and foldouts. Since the early 1960s, Beard has photographed **AFRICA**, its wildlife and women with a passion that is uniquely beautiful, original and wild. Larger than

life, this is the man who was famously trampled by an elephant in pursuit of his art. The Art Edition, published by Taschen, costs £1,350 (to purchase for a February delivery, visit www.taschen.com).
