This collection of celestial maps by Dutch-German mathematician and cosmographer Andreas Cellarius (c. 1596-1665) brings back to life a masterpiece from the Golden Age of celestial cartography. First published in 1660, the complete 29 double-folio maps depict the world systems of Ptolemy, Copernicus and Tycho Brahe, the motions of the sun, the moon and the planets, and the constellations in various views. Superbly embellished with richly decorated borders, the atlas features some of the most spectacular illustration in the history of astronomy.
