**Burton Holmes Travelogues:
The Greatest Traveller of His Time,
1892-1952**

Remember the old Hank Snow song, I've Been Everywhere? Well, Burton Holmes, The U.S. photographer (1870-1958), was everywhere. He visited nearly every country in the world, shooting more than 30,000 photographs and 500,000 feet of film. The result is this glorious book (as one expects from Taschen), featuring colour and black-and-white photos such as a punting party on the Thames in 1897, a throng of Korean men in horsehair hats in 1901 and a Madrid street in 1928. Armchair travel at its best.
