The 190 pages are mainly photographs of classic brasseries, little bistros and gourmet restaurants, showing many enticing, albeit empty, dining rooms.

Parisian way must be its objective. The charming eating establishments are presented by district, for example. Champs-Élysées/Étoile or Marais/Bastille, and each section starts with a nice-looking, illustrated map. There is basic information about each restaurant (opening hours, prices, etc.) in English, German and French. Not the most informative guide, nor the one you'll pick if you want to travel light, but it is a pretty book to flick through and dream of dinner in Paris.
