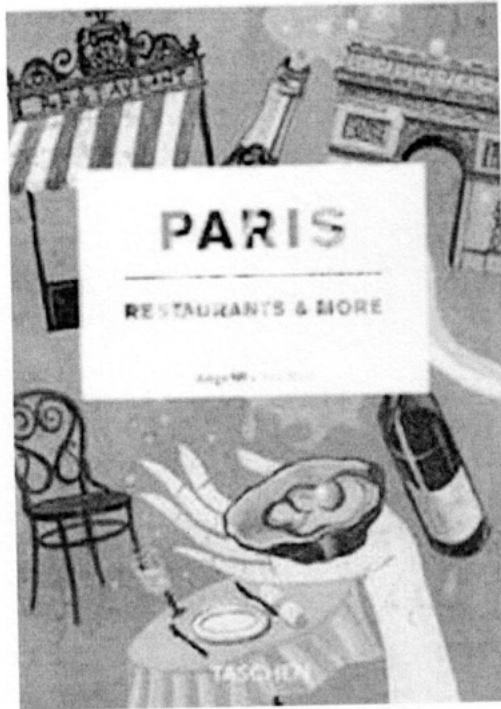


## "Paris, Restaurants & More" by Angelika Taschen

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Like it's twin, Paris: Shops & More, **Paris: Restaurants & More** is not so much a guidebook as it is a hot-list of the top cafes, bars, bistros and food shops in the city of light. Featuring such notables as Brasserie Balzar, Café de Flore, Mariage Frères, and the Bar du George V, this is definitely a "brag book" rather than a guide on great restaurants in Paris.

Rather than bore the reader with endless facts and description, each featured establishment is "described" simply through a few brilliant photographs, with the bare minimum of accompanying information: the address, phone number, website, opening hours, average price, and a one or two

sentence description. The simplicity and elegance is brilliant!
