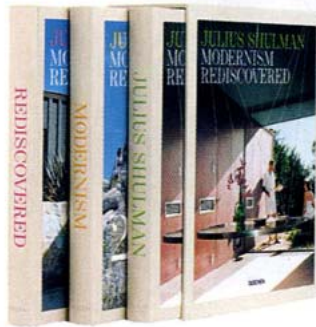


5 REASONS TO READ... JULIUS SHULMAN: MODERNISM REDISCOVERED

1 In our September issue, we took you inside the LA home of architectural photographer Julius Shulman, who made California's Modernist houses world-famous during the Fifties. If you were hooked, you'll need to read the new three-volume monograph on the great man.

2 It features buildings by legends such as Gehry and Mies van der Rohe in locations across the US and Mexico, Hong Kong and Israel.

3 The gorgeous photographs will fascinate anyone who loves vintage interiors, colour palettes, photography and even fashion (there are lots of well-dressed people in Julius's pictures).



4 You also get an extensive biography, plus personal reflections from the man himself. It all adds up to a vivid portrait of a bygone glamorous era.

5 Though the trilogy costs a wallet-clenching £200, we reckon this is a historic publication that you'll be able to treat as an heirloom.
