Sebastião Salgado

Sebastião Salgado is one of the most popular photojournalists in the world and a massive inspiration to students of photography and photojournalism.

His early b&w images from Brazil have done more than any other to keep sales of monochrome film flowing out of shops in this oversaturated digital age.

This latest offering from the master covers his 30 years of picture-taking in Africa. With incredible images from the Dinka tribes in Sudan and the Himba in Namibia, there are gorillas and volcanoes and displaced people through the entire continent. Salgado's trademark extreme black tones and equally extreme whites combined with the African light have worked photographic wonders.
