Taschen's lush new monograph of Michelangelo's complete works is a must-have for every art lover's library



For admirers of Renaissance art, Taschen's large format book on Michelangelo's

work is a real treat. Its centrepiece is a magnificent fold-out spread of the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel in Rome (above; two details of figures from the fresco are also shown left). Plus there's a biography exploring the artist's passions and peccadilloes (solitary by nature, he also amassed immense wealth and was a shrewd property investor) and copious illustrations of his works. *Michelangelo: Complete Works* by Frank Zöllner, Christof Thoenes and Thomas Pöpper (Taschen, £120)
