



## THE BIG PICTURE

The fame of Mexican muralist Diego Rivera has been somewhat eclipsed by his feminist icon wife Frida Kahlo. This could in part be due to the fact that his epic transformations of emblematic buildings in Mexico and the US cannot be transported to galleries. **Diego Rivera: The Complete Murals** (Taschen, £120) is a beautiful attempt to bring us a taste of his work's majesty. This massive, 29x44cm, 674-page, exquisitely printed tome shows all the Latin American communist folk hero's grand murals in large-scale detail, allowing Rivera's unique pictorial language and ability to pack each scene with dynamism and emotion to shine through. This is accompanied with essays, selected paintings, photographs, documents and drawings. Fifty years after his death, it's a fitting celebration of the great man's work.
