This monograph celebrates the career of Spanish-born Calatrava, the only architect to exhibit work at both the Museum of Modern Art and the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York. It's packed with plans, sketches and photos of his masterpieces, such as the stadiums for the 2004 Athens Olympic Games and the suspended swimming pool for Zurich's Federal Institute of Technology. Calatrava collaborated on this tome, even creating watercolour drawings - a fitting contribution from a man whose output combines architecture, art and engineering.
