



Ed Fox: Glamour from the Ground Up
You probably never thought you'd want to buy a coffee table book devoted to women's feet, but you were wrong. Fox's appreciation for the lower appendages runs deep, as does his skill for capturing them magnificently, a product, surely, of his years of work with *Leg Show* and other fine adult publications of that sort. Publisher Taschen, famous for books about art, architecture and similarly refined things, gives this title the same treatment it would, say, a book about the Frank Lloyd Wright's Prairie Style houses, or botanical illustrations from the 19th century. There's more to this book than feet – the other curves of women like Dita Von Teese, Aria Giovanni and Jewel De'Nyle are hardly neglected – but there really need not be. *Ed Fox: Glamour From the Ground Up*, Edited by Dian Hanson, Taschen, \$40.
