Richard Meier has been a central figure in U.S. contemporary architecture, and with more recent buildings such as the Jubilee Church in Rome, he has earned international acclaim. Known for carefully conceived grid plans and frequent use of white, Richard Meier is a master of light and space, able to adapt his style to very different circumstances and locations. Meier's career, up to his most recent designs for New York and Shenzhen, is included in this volume, created in close collaboration among the architect, the author, and the graphic designer Massimo Vignelli.
