Pritzker and Praemium Imperiale laureate Richard Meier, the New York-based architect, has been making news since he completed the Lambert House, a pre-fab structure, in the early 1960s. In the almost half-century since, Meier has changed America's built landscape, and Europe's, too, with museums, corporate headquarters, houses and more that reveal his uncanny mastery of light and space, formalist use of the grid and passionate preference for white. His oeuvre to date is selectively and beautifully documented in this hefty book, handsomely designed by Massimo Vignelli. The analysis by editor and architecture specialist Philip Jodidio is insightful.
