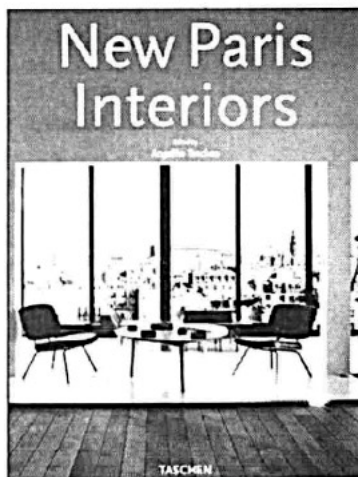


Light therapy
