



#### DOMUS VOL. 2 (TASCHEN)

Widely recognized as the world's most influential architecture and design journal, *domus* has, for 80 years, maintained the vision instilled by its founder, famed Milanese architect Gio Ponti. The acclaimed periodical is perhaps best recognized for its comprehensive and unmitigated approach to exploring design periods, from Art Deco to Late Modern. Part of a 12-volume collection of reprints, *domus Vol. 2* contains reproductions of original pages published in the 1940s by its predecessor. As evidenced here; Modernism saw great advancements, thanks to the forward-thinking Italian designs of key players like Carlo Mollino, Gian Luigi Banfi and Giuseppe Terragni, and the emergence of organic design.
