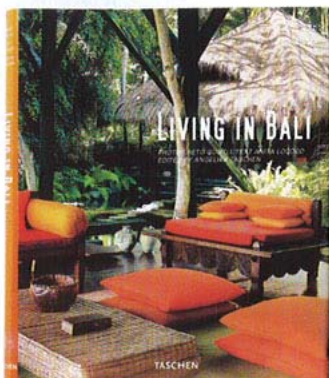


5 REASONS TO READ...
