



FRANK LLOYD WRIGHT: COMPLETE WORKS, VOLUME 3

Considered by many to be the greatest architect of all time, Frank Lloyd Wright and his meticulously constructed masterpieces set the benchmark for modern architects worldwide. Now, all his legendary works can be seen collectively on the pages of Taschen's new coffee table book. The \$200, three-volume monograph features approximately 1,100 of Wright's designs, both realized and unrealized. The book covers every square inch of Wright's progressive works, from his Usonian concept home and "living architecture" buildings, to one of New York's best-known, contemporary landmarks: The Guggenheim Museum. Dedicated to Wright's post-World War II designs, *Volume 3* pays homage to the artist's incorporation of solar energy, groundbreaking projects and hexagonal floor plans with intersecting angles. With volumes one and two scheduled for later releases, the series delves into each of Wright's defining periods, with his famous works jumping off the page.
