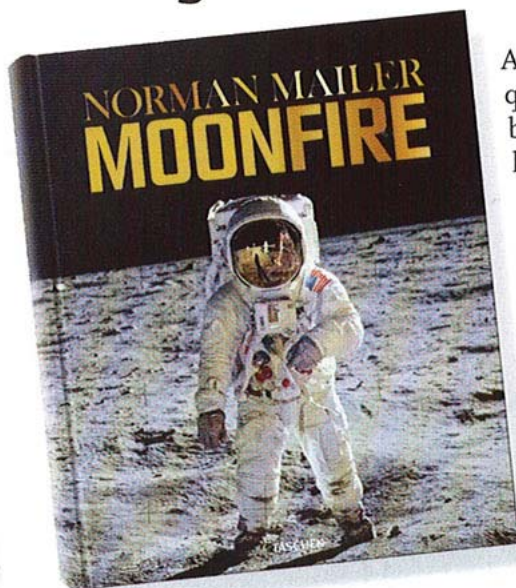


# Apollo 11 book price is truly out of this world



Any printer of high-quality books or brochures is likely to have one job that sticks out in the memory, something just a little bit special. Here at Post Script, we can't imagine many print jobs topping the latest version of the late Norman Mailer's *Moonfire*.

The extra-large commemorative

book, which is based on accounts of the Apollo 11 moon landing, will have 1,969 copies printed each signed by astronaut Buzz Aldrin.

The catch? The hardcover, 348pp book, which is available from publisher Taschen, retails for £650.

For the truly avid space enthusiast though, the final 12 copies of the book will come complete with a piece of moon rock in the binding.

According to *The Telegraph*, samples range from 0.4g to a 30.34g rock while conservative estimates for such editions reach the "hundreds of thousands of dollars" mark.
