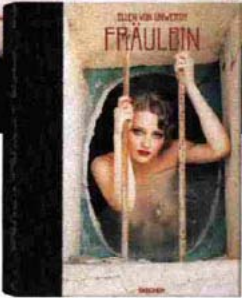




Teddy, by Ellen von Unwerth, 2006; below, the cover of her new book, *Fräulein*



GIRLS ON FILM

Fräulein, published by Taschen, is a limited-edition collection of **Ellen von Unwerth's** photography with accompanying text by **Ingrid Sischy**. These candid portraits—at the same time sensual and saucy—shed a playful and even bawdy light onto some of the most intriguing women of our era, including Drew Barrymore, Carla Bruni and Kate Moss. The German-born von Unwerth worked as a fashion model for 10 years before turning to photography in the mid 1980s. Her pictures have appeared in magazines such as *Vogue* and *Vanity Fair*, and she has exhibited in London, New York and Paris. —Geraldine de Puy
