Moonfire by Norman Mailer. When the moon landing happened, *Life* magazine asked Mailer to remark on the historic event, and that classic essay is reprinted here. Actually, it's re-reprinted, because **Taschen** released this book last year in a gold-standard edition, priced high enough (\$1,500) that a young lover of space would have to choose between mortgage payments or Mailer payments.
