A LADY-KILLING COMBINATION OF innate charm and honed technique, New York-born photographer Sante D'Orazio, 54, has been among the world's leading fashion photographers since the Eighties. His latest coffee-table book, *Barely Private*, features some of the most eye-catching images of famous women from his long career, including candid shots of Kate Moss, Naomi Campbell, Angelina Jolie and Diane Kruger. Our favourite is this photo of the young Christy Turlington, fresh from the shower in a Montauk, New York, motel room, in 1992. "A lot of these girls are friends of mine outside of the business and something magical just happens," says D'Orazio, whose diary notes accompany a stunning collection of intimate portraits.
