

**A SNEAK PEEK** It's a glitzy game of through the keyhole. From Antwerp to Zurich via Chiang Mai, Copenhagen, Mumbai, Tokyo and lots more, Angelika Taschen's new series on contemporary interiors stars some of the coolest – and most tasteful and interesting – homes on the planet. Taschen's contacts book is impressive. There's the minimal Swedish country house of Fabien Baron, the French *Vogue* creative director and tastemaker, which was designed by John Pawson. Roberto Cavalli's Milanese dramatic apartment is a perfect reflection of his flamboyant personality. The rich variety is the most exciting aspect. From flea market romance to arch minimalism, there is a fantastic array of great – and beautifully illustrated – interiors ideas to snaffle.
