NEWTON'S LAW

➤ **HELMUT NEWTON, POLAROIDS IS A NEW BOOK FROM PUBLISHER TASCHEN** which, as the name suggests, is a collection of test prints made and saved by the legendary German-born photographer. Polaroids were once a crucial tool for photographers to test their shots before shooting on film. These were often discarded, but Newton saved his and this book is a rare chance to see the setup shots from some of his greatest shoots, including *SUMO*, *A Gun for Hire* and *Work*, all taken over a period of decades. He first achieved international fame in the 1970s while working principally for French *Vogue*, and his celebrity and influence grew over the decades. Put together by his widow, June, this collection captures the magic of the photographer's shoots as only Polaroids can.
