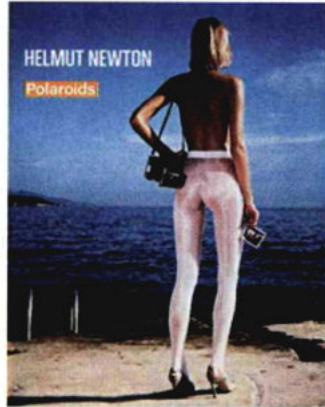

If one photographer divides opinion like no other, it's the late Helmut Newton. His work is regarded by many as avant-garde, daring and sexy, while others find it offensive, overrated and pornographic. If you're a Newton aficionado, you'll no doubt find much to enjoy in this latest book of his work. If you sit in the camp of the uninspired, then *Polaroids* will do nothing to change your opinion. The book features a collection of his Polaroids put together by his widow, June Newton. Newton started using Polaroids in the 1970s, in particular for his fashion work, and this book has 300 or so that cover every era, from shoots for *Vogue* and Yves San Laurent to *Stern* and *Playboy*.
