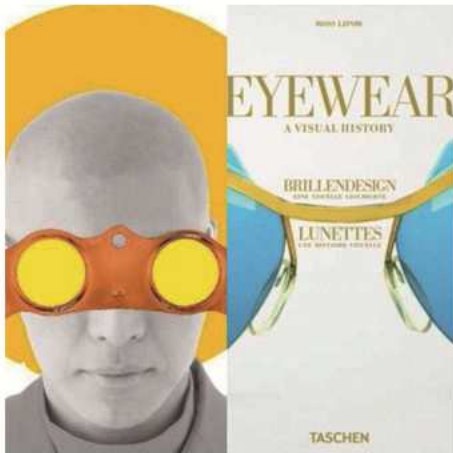


## Eyewear Moss Lipow



The New York artist Moss Lipow and eyewear designer just has released the book '[Eyewear a Optical History](#)'. The book was published by [TASCHEN](#) and is featuring the eyewear history over the past 500 years. This lavishly illustrated book is available in six languages and it is a true eyewear feast.

Moss Lipow is an avant-garde eyewear designer whose celebrity fans include David Bowie, [Lady Gaga](#), Mary Kate and Ashley Olsen, and Elton John. He was a 2010 CFDA/Vogue Fashion Fund finalist, and has been nominated for the 2011 National Design Award, sponsored by the Smithsonian Institute. His eponymous line of eyewear is sold worldwide.

For over two decades eyewear designer Moss Lipow trawled eBay, auction houses, garage sales, and flea markets worldwide, amassing glasses and photographs for his renowned collection. The [book](#) also contain 1200 images from his museum-quality collection of [vintage](#) and antique pieces, as well as examples of his own incredible custom creations.
