Beautifully cloth bound in a retro-style, this is a 2 inch thick collection of *The New York Times*' '36 Hours' column, which lists the essential places to see, things to do, restaurants to eat in and people to encounter on short weekend breaks in the United States. 150 locations are covered, from New York City to the Niobrara River Valley, Nebraska; from Kauai to Boise, Idaho, complete with excellent, evocative photographs and useful maps. It's an itinerary of items from mid-afternoon Friday to Sunday morning, or a check-list or just a suggestion sheet, whatever you want it to be. Even if you're from the (mostly) well known destinations you'll find some surprises and some great ideas. Those Americans using the UK as a base for continental explorations and will be pleased to hear that Taschen are publishing a European version later this year. – **MiB**
