**Living in Morocco**  
by **Barbara & René Stoeltje.**

This interior design book features some of the most stunning private homes and traditional hotels in Marrakesh, Tangier and the Atlas Mountains. Morocco has been popular with rich Europeans since the 19th century, but is most associated with the 1960s jet set of heiresses, writers and rock stars. The homes featured mainly belong to a variety of wealthy European artists and designers, but there is one home owned by a rural Berber family. Highlights include a beautifully restored palace in Medina, and the Marrakesh home of legendary American designer Bill Willis. The book's full-page photographs are stunning, and the text is charming and informative.
