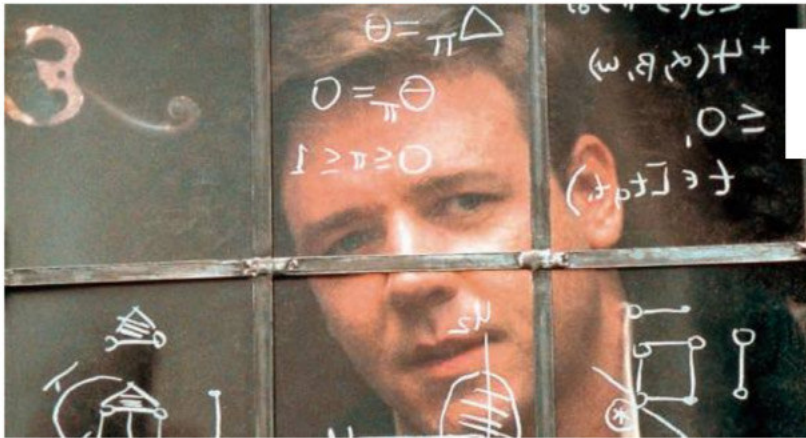


'Movies of the 2000s' Book Review
