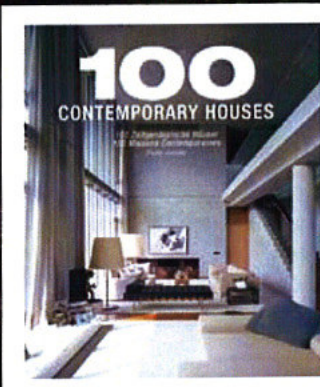
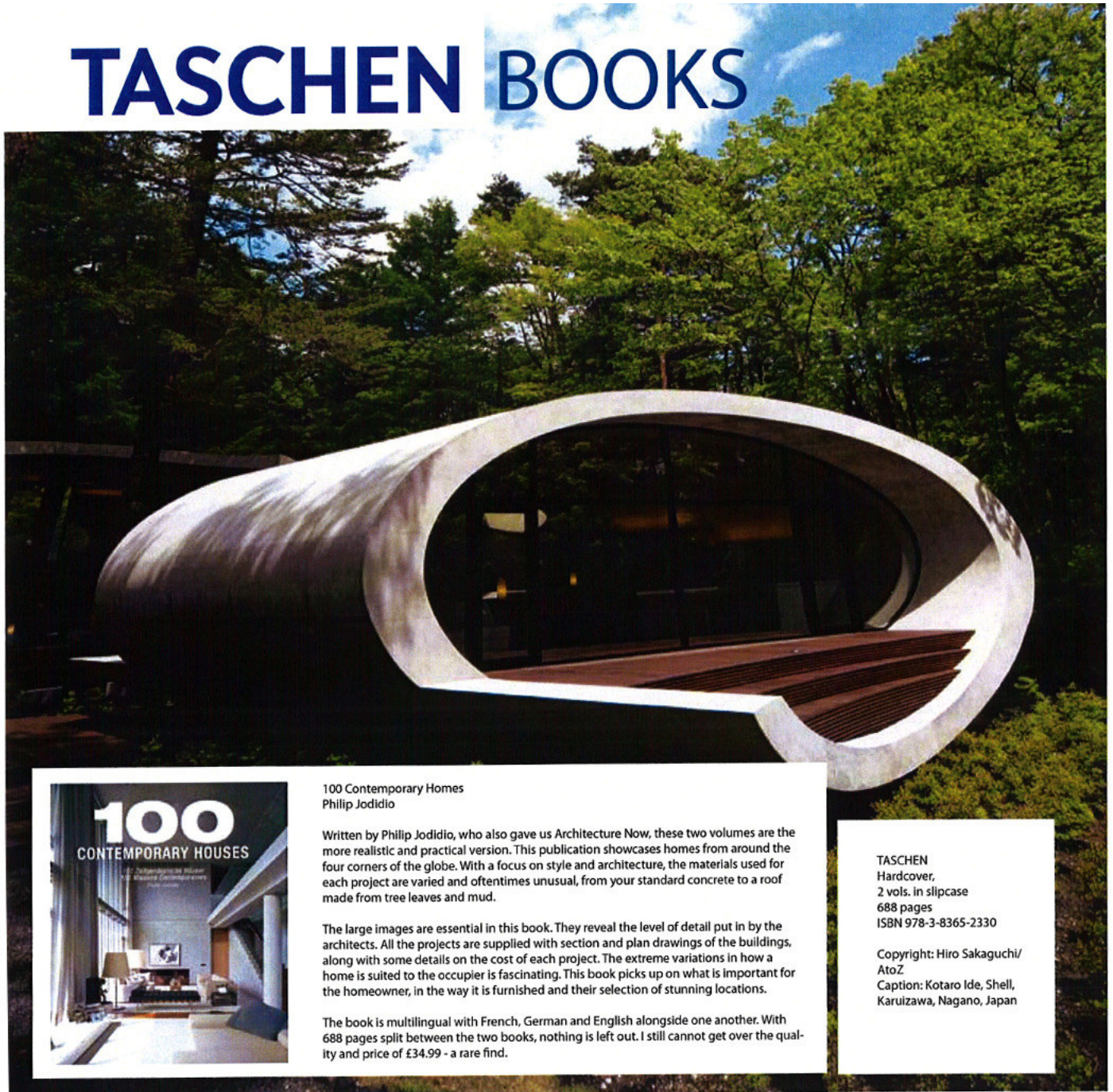


# TASCHEN BOOKS

Written by Philip Jodidio, who also gave us Architecture Now, these two volumes are the more realistic and practical version. This publication showcases homes from around the four corners of the globe. With a focus on style and architecture, the materials used for each project are varied and oftentimes unusual, from your standard concrete to a roof made from tree leaves and mud.

The large images are essential in this book. They reveal the level of detail put in by the architects. All the projects are supplied with section and plan drawings of the buildings, along with some details on the cost of each project. The extreme variations in how a home is suited to the occupier is fascinating. This book picks up on what is important for the homeowner, in the way it is furnished and their selection of stunning locations.

The book is multilingual with French, German and English alongside one another. With 688 pages split between the two books, nothing is left out. I still cannot get over the quality and price of £34.99 - a rare find.
