Dezeen produced a series of short videos with Marc Newson at his studio in London on the occasion of his new tome from Taschen set to be released next month. The video is part one of a five part series where Newson takes us through the book and speaks candidly about his work. As he flips through the pages, he reveals how hands on he was with his earlier pieces—making everything on his own, including the famous Lockheed Lounge. Taschen ties in the influence Newson has on pop culture with anecdotal images of where the Lounge has been seen, including, of all things, Trey Parker and Matt Stone's Team America. *Marc Newson Works* is 610 pages and took seven years to make, covering 95 percent of Newson's work to date. It's no wonder why this series is broken into five parts.
